Dear Ohana of the Newman Center,

Happy Easter to one and all! Our Easter season will last until the Feast of Pentecost, May 23. Sometimes we lose sight of the beauty and prayerfulness of this great feast of the Church. So, this weekend, I will present some prayerful reflections on some of the Easter scriptures for the next few weeks:

Risen Jesus, open our minds and hearts. Let us see and welcome your presence.

1. Their eyes were opened, and they recognized him (*Luke 24:31*).

All around me Easter is happening. God continues to reveal His love, to extend invitations to growth, to offer my hope. What is God's latest revelation to me? How has this changed by life?

2. Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast" (*John 21:12*).

Jesus invited the disciples to come and to nourished with food that he had prepared. What food am I being offered for the nourishment of my spirit? What food do I accept and what do I reject?

3. "He is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him"

(*Matthew 28:7*). Galilee...the place of much action and healing during the ministry of Jesus. I have my own Galilee. It is there that I will see the Risen One. Is there anything I need to change or adapt so that I will more readily recognize Jesus in my life?

4. "Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised...."(*Matthew 28:5-6*).

Fear filled the hearts of those who had loved Jesus. They found it difficult to believe the Easter message. What keeps me from hearing the truth that is being offered to me? What is my resistance?

5. Jesus said to her, "Mary!" (*John 20:16*). In the moment of hearing her name called Mary recognized Jesus. With the sound of her name, she was bonded in love once again. When and how have I known intimacy with the Holy One? Do I believe that I, too, am very dear in God's eyes?

6. "Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road while he was opening the scriptures to us?" (*Luke 24:32*). What a wonderful moment of surprise and joy for the two on the road to Emmaus. They must have felt relief after their intense struggle. I, too, have had my life events that were blessed with joy and happiness. For what do I offer gratitude this day?

7. "So they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his disciples" (*Matthew 28:8*). The women went to tell the good news. They ran with excitement and joy and a bit of trepidation too. How do I proclaim, through my life and words, that I am aware of the powerful presence of God in my midst? How do I witness what I believe?

As Jesus came among them, he recognized the fear and disbelief that filled his followers' hearts. He greeted them with "Peace."

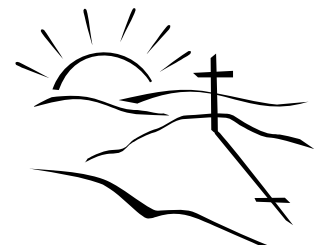
How will I greet myself and my world with peace during the Easter season?

## Conversations on the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius

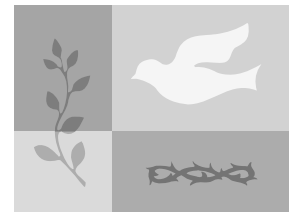
- ◆ 7:30 PM, Tues evening at Newman
