Dear Friends

This past week, the academic dean of Loyola Chicago/Rome Campus wrote to ask prayers for her sister whose cancer has returned. "Laurie" is not yet fifty. Just a couple of years ago, another sister lost her battle with cancer at the age of 42. Such dark moments in the lives of people close to us make us aware of how precious life is. Within a community of friends, family and parish, people find comfort and companionship in the midst of distress. We feel safe asking for prayers for our various intentions and deepest concerns. It is one of the blessings we experience as a community. Not all have the deepest faith, not all are completely committed, not everyone accepts every teaching yet none of us hesitates to commit to each other the most personal intentions as we gather together to pray even for some things we might regard as trivial.

Three hundred years ago, Jean Pierre de Caussade, S.J. told his students that there is no trivial moment since every moment contains "a divine kingdom and heavenly sustenance" within it. Caussade spoke of the "the sacrament of the present moment." This is sometimes expressed as "living in the now." It requires great trust to surrender to God's will as revealed in each passing second. Who of us can say we unconditionally surrender to that Will? Yet with good people around us, perhaps we can embrace life's difficulties with the assurance that there are many who will take a moment to lift us up in prayer and lend a hand to help us on the journey.
