Date: Sunday, April 22, 2018

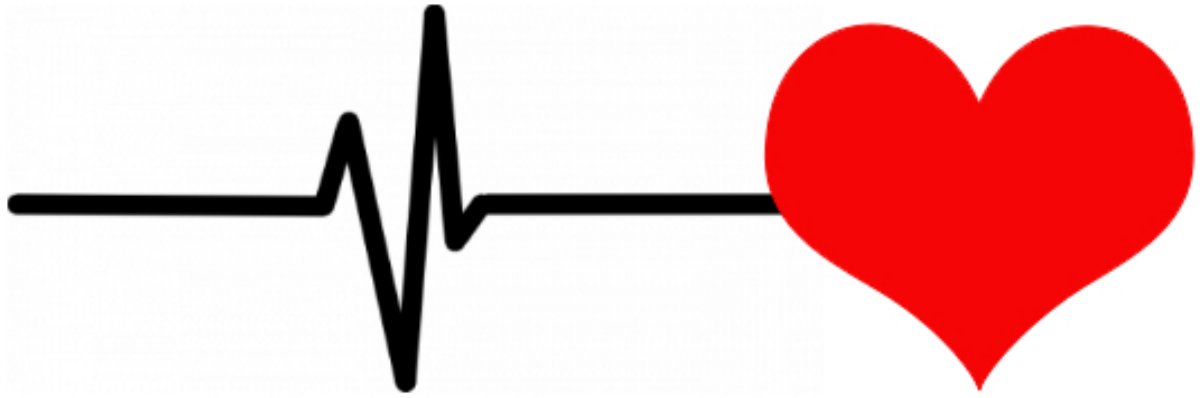
Place: The Muslim Association of Hawai'i Mosque

Leaders of the local Muslim community will be available to answer questions. We will also hear the call to prayer, and have the option of observing or participating in the Mid-Day prayer, which lasts about 10 minutes. It is suggested for dressing to wear long pants for men and women, preferably not too form fitting, and preferably no shorts or tank tops. Women may also wear a long skirt/dress. Long sleeves and small scarfs to cover the hair for women would be wonderful.
