EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

While we wait we strive to grow in the hope that our loving God has held out to us in the coming of Jesus. We look into our hearts now for evidence that we are being God's hopeful people.

Let us recall Jesus' words.

He tells us to love God with our whole heart, our whole soul, our whole mind, and our whole strength (Mk 12:30).

- How seriously do I take my covenant with God; how much does that relationship guide all I think, say, and do?
- How do I seek out the guidance of the Holy Spirit as I strive to fulfill my baptismal promises?
- Am I living the old covenant concerned primarily with external standards and not acknowledging the directives of a wise heart?

Jesus tells us to love our neighbor as we do ourselves (Mk 12:31).

- Have I allowed sacrifices and penances to be the measure of my fidelity to God rather than the love of my neighbor?
- How am I striving to live the spirit of the law in my relationships?
- How am I becoming a person of reconciliation?
- What do I do to strengthen the new covenant present in the hearts of those I see each day?
